Welcome to 2018-2019 school year! As we begin to organize the schedule for our first semester of the 2018-2019 program year, we wanted to take a moment to inform everyone about the iLearn Academy for Grades 4-8 (funded by the  $21^{\text{st}}$  CCLC) that will begin on September  $17^{\text{th}}$ , 2018. Registration is open to all 4th through 8th grade students through the school website until September  $12^{\text{th}}$ , 2018. The program will run Monday through Friday from 3:15 to 6:10 p.m. There is no fee for this program. Each day, students will have one academic class (ELA or MATH), one homework help class, and one enrichment class. The first 65 students who return the "Commitment Form and Packet" will be guaranteed spots in our program.

Enclosed, you will find copies of our Registration Form, Sign Out Permission Form, Code of Conduct, Late Pick Up Fee Policy, Commitment Letter, Snack Waiver, and Photo/ Movie Release. As we look to follow the guidelines that the State of NJ has set for our program, we need to ensure that this paperwork has been returned for each child.

#### CODE OF CONDUCT (Grades 4-8)

iLearn Academy committed to the ideal of academic excellence. This ideal can be attained only in a safe and orderly environment that allows teachers to teach and students to learn. Good behavior and academic achievement are closely related. Hence, we expect all students to behave in a manner that will reflect favorably on themselves, their school, and their community. Respect for the right of all students to receive a quality education requires faithful adherence to school rules and regulations. Fortunately, Hudson ASCS students have traditionally displayed the finest traits of school citizenship. It is our hope that this document will enable all students to continue along the path of success.

The rules and regulations listed below comprise iLearn Academy's Code of Conduct:

- 1. Students should practice good school and classroom attendance and report to both on time. Students must be in their classrooms by 3:15 PM. Students who are repeatedly absent and/or tardy will be reviewed by the Project Director and/or the Coordinator. A parent will be contacted if a student is absent and/or tardy on a frequent basis. Any student who is absent more than five times may be dismissed from this program.
- 2. Students should dress appropriately. No hats, hoods, bandanas (headgear) are to be worn in the building. Sweats tank tops, blouses that expose shoulders and midriff, etc. are inappropriate. Clothing with obscene and/or derogatory slogans/graphics or wording promoting alcohol, tobacco, and drugs is strictly prohibited. Students may not bring water guns, toys, radios (walkmans), beepers/cell phones, skateboards, game boards, dice, playing and collectible cards, electronic games, or other disruptive items to school. Do not bring valuables and large sums of money to school.
- 3. Disrespectful or defiant behavior towards a staff member is not tolerated. Students are expected to follow all reasonable requests and directions given to them by a staff member.
- 4. Students must all sign out/in in the teacher's daily log when leaving the classroom.
- 5. Fighting and bullying are not permitted and may lead to suspensions and other penalties. Assault and other violent physical attacks on students or teachers would result in immediate suspensions and police charges. Any disciplinary infraction will result in a disciplinary report sent to the Site Coordinator.
- 6. Students should respect their school and take pride in it. Vandalism and graffiti in the building or on school grounds can lead to serious penalties. Any disciplinary infraction will result in a disciplinary report sent to the Site Coordinator.
- 7. Obscene language is unacceptable in a school setting. Any disciplinary infraction will result in a disciplinary report sent to the Site Coordinator.
- 8. Possession of controlled substances (drugs, alcohol, cigarettes), stealing, and bringing of knives/weapons of any kind to school are strictly forbidden and will be dealt with severely by school and police officials. Any disciplinary infraction will result in a disciplinary report sent to the Site Coordinator.

- 9. Snack activities will include sitting at your assigned classroom only. Students may only leave their assigned room when given permission by supervising personnel. Students, when given permission to attend the lavatory, must utilize the sign in/out procedure that is established. Students are required to clean up their areas of all food and debris that is on the table and floor.
- 10. Gambling of any kind is prohibited in school or on school grounds at all times. The selling or trading of collectible cards and other objects is prohibited. Students may not sell candy or other items for profit or reasons otherwise in the school building. Any disciplinary infraction will result in a disciplinary report sent to the Site Coordinator.
- 11. Good sportsmanship should be exhibited at all athletic and competitive events. This includes physical education activities, both inside and outside of the classroom setting. Good conduct and manners must be exhibited on all field trips and student visitations. Students must demonstrate good behavior and the proper decorum at all assemblies, concerts, and after school programs that are conducted in the school building.
- 12. Cheating/Plagiarism of any kind is a forbidden behavior. Students are responsible for their own work at all times. Failure of a subject for a marking period and/or the year and suspension from school are consequences for repeated offenses.

Please refer to the Hudson ASCS parent handbook for specific policies, procedures and penalties regarding the Code of Conduct.

We believe that Hudson ASCS students are the best. Continue this tradition by applying the Code of Conduct daily along with a good school attitude and school pride.

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## **Late Pick-up Fee Policy**

iLearn Academy-21st CCLC program ends at 6:10 PM, Monday through Friday. You must notify Site Coordinator as to your time of arrival if after 6:10 PM. If the staff does not hear from you by 6:10 PM, it is the 21st Century program's policy to begin calling your emergency contacts to pick up your child. It is very stressful to some children when their parent does not arrive on time. A fee of \$5 will be charged for every 5 minutes past 6:15 PM. You must pay this fee in order for your child to return to iLearn Academy-21st CCLC program.

If the late fee payment is not received, the student will be removed from iLearn Academy-21st CCLC program until the payment is made.

If a parent/guardian fails to pick up the child until 6:30 pm and no one has been contacted, the Site Coordinator will contact legal authorities to pick up the child.
